How to install previously downloaded apps that are no longer available on the App Store

Users who have already downloaded the apps and made in-app purchases should be able to re-download the apps on newer devices when <u>utilizing the same Account</u> that was used to originally download the app.

To install a previously downloaded app onto your iOS device, make sure you are logged in with the same iTunes/iCloud account that was used to originally download the app.

- Open the App Store and tap on the Account icon in the upper right.
- Tap on the Purchased menu.
- In the search bar, type in the name of the app you are looking to install, for example: Smart Cycle Tech City. Once located, tap on the Cloud icon to download and install the app.

- In the list of apps, locate the one you wish to install, and tap the checkmark next to it.
- After selecting the app in the list, tap on the Download button.
